Michael Burcham, current director of the Vanderbilt Accelerator Summer Business Institute and future inaugural president of the Nashville Entrepreneur Center, has found a way to bring both worlds together.

Just two weeks before Burcham takes his [post as the NEC](#), the center and Nashville Area Chamber of Commerce will launch a project whereby Vanderbilt Accelerator students will be charged with developing an “incubator-type program” for entrepreneurs interested in music business.

The people who participate in the Accelerator program come out with business knowledge and savvy that only this type of intensely creative atmosphere can create,” Burcham said in a statement. “A specialized version of Accelerator would be the perfect model for jumpstarting entrepreneurs tackling the music industry.”
